

FAQ's - STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Do all students have to pay for Membership?

From 1st January 2022 Student membership will be compulsory and all students must be members of the IAB before registering for qualifications.

All learners will be required to register for student membership via [the IAB website](#) and pay the annual fee of £50. Once registered they will receive an e-certificate indicating their membership level and the date that the membership is valid until.

Do I need to sign up for student membership to take an exam if I am already a full member of the IAB?

No. If you already have full membership with the IAB, you are not required to sign up for an additional Student membership.

When will Students have access to the student area on the IAB Website?

Access will be granted on confirmation of membership.

Does the student membership apply to New Centres that have been recently been accredited?

Student membership will be compulsory for all learners. This now means we align with all other awarding and professional bodies; student membership was introduced on 1st January 2022.

Can centres pay student membership fees on behalf of the students?

All learners are responsible for paying their own fees.

What is the difference between registering for a qualification and registering for an exam?

IAB qualifications are separate to membership so therefore you will need to register for an IAB qualification after purchasing membership.

What happens if my student membership expires before I complete my qualification?

You must have an in-date membership at the point of completing your qualification.

Is the £50.00 student membership fee a one-off charge?

The £50.00 is an annual fee. Your membership must be renewed yearly in order to complete your qualifications.

What happens if I change my email address?
