The History of the IAB

The IAB was formed in 1973 by the Council of the Institute of Administrative Accountants (IAA). This was done to retain links with its bookkeeping history dating back to 1916.

The objective of the IAB was to offer basic qualifications in Bookkeeping at three levels, Preliminary, Intermediate and Final, with the final level being the equivalent to GCE A Level, a far cry from the breadth of qualifications now offered by the IAB.

In September 2022 the International Association of Bookkeepers (IAB) changed its name to the Institute of Accountants and Bookkeepers (IAB). This change was made to reflect the diversity of our membership and our qualification offering.

In 2023 the IAB celebrates its 50th year, the name change, specifically the word 'institute' endorses the heritage of the organisation and acknowledges the pioneering work that continues in education, Anti Money Laundering and the lobbying of legislation in government on behalf of the industry.

The IAB is recognised by HM Treasury to regulate our members for the purposes of the Money Laundering Regulations 2017 and 2019.

The combined heritage and global footprint of IAB and LCCI will ensure that universally recognised qualifications remain credible, relevant, and accessible across 4 continents in 30+ countries.



We offer accredited training, support, and continuing development from the beginning of a student's journey and throughout their career. This includes flexible, Ofqual-regulated qualifications, continued professional development and frequent regulatory updates.

The IAB is also a Professional Body Supervisor (PBS) listed in the UK Money Laundering Regulations (MLRs). This enables the Institute to provide the required supervision for an accountancy or bookkeeping practice of any professional IAB Member or Fellow.

In doing so, the IAB is responsible for overseeing the practice's compliance with the MLRs and supports them in adhering to these regulations. The Institute also collaborates with HMRC (His Majesty's Revenue and Customs) and other leading financial bodies such as HMRC Employment Consultative Committee, the Financial Conduct Authority, Ofqual and The Financial Services Skill Commission.

Accountancy and bookkeeping are well-respected professions, and the IAB works to uphold high standards of competence and professional conduct. Collaborating across the industry there is also a strong focus on the lobbying of legislation within government to ensure the industry continues to maintain the high standards the IAB has worked to establish.



In line with our strategic goals in 2023 we will launch a range of modules, levels 4-7 designed to be either standalone or combined, where collectively they equate to a degree. Each level will have a set of core modules and the learner will get the opportunity to select how they want to tailor their learning to be either business or finance focused. As an additional layer there are vertical pathways that apply to either focus covering topics such as marketing, logistics and data.

IAB qualifications are regulated by Ofqual, QiW and CCEA therefore guaranteed to meet specified quality standards. They can be accessed via a range of study options, our approved centres and our online IAB Education platform which provides 'on demand' accessibility to our range of qualifications.


